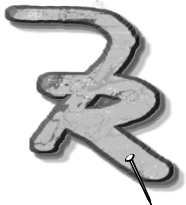

The Delores Ross Foundation's mission is to connect businesses that are looking to make charitable donations to women that are victims of domestic violence, and those shelters that provide assistance to them. The Delores Ross Foundation knows the pain and anguish of being in a relationship of any kind that is abusive physically, mentally and/or other wise. Most women that find themselves in these kinds of relationships have no desire to remain there, they just don't know how to 'get out'...or at least get out safely and permanently.



Within the last year, 7% of American women (3.9 million) who are married or living with someone as a couple were physically abused, and 37% (20.7 million) were verbally or emotionally abused by their spouse or partner. (The Commonwealth Fund, N.Y. 2009)



Since 2002, The Delores Ross Foundation has been able to funnel thousands of dollars in money, clothing, food and education to over 20 shelters in Ohio, New York, North Carolina and Virginia.

Our mission is to provide resources to shelters that offer support and rehabilitation to battered women and their children; and to change attitudes and social institutions that foster and perpetuate violence. We are aggressively working to change legislation that will impose stiffer penalties on those men that abuse women to include life sentences for those that commit heinous abuse.



The Bureau of Justice Statistics states that on the average, more than three women are murdered by their husbands or boyfriends every day AFTER they go back.



The Delores Ross Foundation is a non profit organization that reaches out to shelters of any size, any location...anytime. Our vision is to have our communities free of domestic violence and every home be a safe haven for the family it shelters.
